

Denver medical team receives live Ebola vaccines Nov 28, 9News A few medical employees at Denver Health made history Monday as some of the first people to receive the live Ebola vaccine for preventative measures. Denver Health's High Risk Infection Team is a part of the Regional Emerging Special Pathogen Treatment Center – one of 13 centers in the U.S. that can treat infectious diseases like Ebola. "Even though there are no current outbreaks in the world, we want to make sure that people have the chance to be protected in case we need to take care of a patient that has a disease with a mortality potentially of 70%," Dr. Maria Frank, a recipient of the vaccine, said.
