## **HEALTHCARE EQUALITY**

Denver Health has been recognized year after year as a Leader in Healthcare Equality. We proudly serve the LGBTQ community, the uninsured, Denver police officers, and the homeless. Each year, we treat nearly one-third of Denver County's population, care for more than 60,000 children, and deliver one-third of all Denver babies.



## **FAMILY HEALTH CENTERS**

Our nine Family Health Centers stretch from Winter Park to Montbello and serve as additional access points for primary care, dental services, pharmacy services, and much more. In 2015, our Family Health Centers completed 477,271 patient visits.



### SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS

Students of Denver Public schools and their siblings can receive free care at any one of our 17 School-based Health Centers. Located within the school, students receive primary care, health education, behavioral health therapy, and other services with minimal time away from class.



## PROMOTING PUBLIC HEALTH

Denver Public Health is a nationally recognized public health department that works with many partners to make Denver a healthy community for all people. As an example, Denver Public Health's Center for Positive Health cares for patients living with HIV. In 2015, none of the patients seen in the clinic progressed to develop AIDS, and there have been no cases of mother to child HIV transmission in the last 15 years.

### **NURSELINE**

Denver Health's NurseLine is staffed by trained nurses 24 hours a day, seven days a week to answer your medical questions and even fill certain prescriptions.



### **MYCHART**

To ensure simple access to health records we now offer MyChart. Patients can message their provider, schedule an appointment, request prescription refills, and more—all from a smart phone or computer.

## THE ACUTE CENTER FOR **EATING DISORDERS**

The ACUTE Center for Eating Disorders is the only specialized medical stabilization program in the nation for patients with life-threatening eating disorders. The program has been credited with saving more than 800 lives and is a top-ranked facility for this type of treatment.



## **ROCKY MOUNTAIN** POISON AND DRUG CENTER

In case of poisoning or chemical exposures, you can rely on Rocky Mountain Poison and Drug Center, which handles more than 150,000 calls relating to poisoning emergencies each year. Our healthcare professionals also provide clear information for both providers and patients on the safe use of medical devices and pharmaceutical drugs.



## DENVER HEALTH MEDICAL PLAN

Since its creation in 1997, Denver Health Medical Plan, a nonprofit health insurance plan, actively involves members in their healthcare by promoting wellness and disease prevention, while providing access to health services. The Plan has increased in enrollment over the past five years by nearly 40,000 members.



## **Denver Health is a national leader** in emergency and trauma care.

Our Level I Rocky Mountain Regional Trauma Center treats the most critically injured patients with a 98 percent trauma survival rateone of the best in the state.



The Denver Health Paramedic **Division operates Denver's 911 Emergency Medical Response System**—one of the busiest in the region. We handle more than 100,000 emergency calls and transport 70,000 patients to area hospitals each year.



**Our prestigious EMS Education** Department trains paramedics, EMTs, and first responders. Since 2012, we have provided more than 1,000 police officers with tourniquet training and as a result, nine officers' lives have been saved.





As a teaching institution, Denver Health is dedicated to the education and training of the next generation of health care providers. Denver Health serves as the clinical training facility for students who are pursuing 34 different health professions and is an education and research partner with the University Of Colorado School Of Medicine.



**Denver Health has received funding for 477 health care research projects in the past year.** The U.S. Department of Defense and Department of Health and Human Services are just two of the many organizations we partner with to find new ways to deliver top quality health care to patients.
