HIP: Healthcare Interest Program - Denver Health

START HERE!

- 1. Apply to the Healthcare Interest Program.
 - a. Apply via the online application located at: https://www.denverhealth.org/for-professionals/careers/healthcare-interest-program
- 2. Once you receive notification of your acceptance:
 - b. Solidify your HIP Experience by completing the following steps:

SOLIDIFY YOUR Denver Health HIP EXPERIENCE

- Contact Jessica Godo (<u>Jessica.godo@ucdenver.edu</u>) and your HIP Experience Advisor, Madison Kelleher: (<u>madison.kelleher@ucdenver.edu</u>) to request your background check process to begin.
 NOTE: you will need to complete an online form and the check can take 24-72 hours to receive back. You will attach the completed background check info to your Experience in Handshake.
- 2. Ensure your required trainings and immunizations are completed (see below).
- 3. Request your Experience in Handshake: You can find the Experiences section under the Career Center tab in Handshake. Be sure to fill in each field, if you don't know something, put 'N/A' or 'Unsure' and you can update it later.
 - You will need the following information before requesting your Experience:
 - The name, email and phone number of the **Site Supervisor** (person supervising your work at Denver Health) this is typically the HIP Coordinator (Teresa O'Connell).
 - Start date (Fall) and end date (Spring) that you have agreed upon.
 - A full **description** of the HIP. You can copy and paste from an electronic file if needed.
 - 4-8 learning objectives that you are hoping to learn and develop in the HIP.
 - The course number and Faculty Sponsor (CLAS 3939 Dr. Josina O'Connell).
 - Attach all immunization records (complete list below) as a PDF.
 - Attach any training certificates/proof of completion for the following: HIPPA and Environmental Health & Safety if you have them. If you do not have these, notify your HIP Experience Advisor, Madison Kelleher (<u>Madison.kelleher@ucdenver.edu</u>).

ACCESS TRAININGS

- 1. Click "Log in" in the top right corner then.
- 2. Click "Create new account" in the bottom right corner.
- 3. Username must be **first initial of first name, last name, ID#** (if applicable) with no spaces (example: Cory Smith 123456 username: **CSmith123456**).
- 4. Create password.
- 5. Enter your email address (CU email address is preferable if you have one).
- 6. Enter your full first and last name.
- 7. Enter "Intern Training" in the city/town category.
- 8. Click "Create my new account".
- 9. Complete the applicable training: Laboratory Safety, Chemical Waste Management Training, Blood Borne Pathogen Training, Regulated Medical Waste Training.

 When you have completed <u>ALL</u> of your required trainings, notify Alison McGrath via email and include: Full name, Username to training site, ID #, the courses you completed. If you have any questions please contact me at <u>alison.m.mcgrath@ucdenver.edu</u> or 303-724-0242.

If your research project involves a hospital or clinic that is subject to the HIPAA privacy and security regulations, then you will also need to complete the CITI Health Information Privacy and Security training: You can access HIPAA Research Course: CITI Health Information Privacy and Security (HIPS) at www.citiprogram.org.

- 1. Select 'University of Colorado Denver' as your Institution.
- 2. Register with your username and password.
- 3. You will be presented with a series of questions or options to enable you to enroll in the Learner Group appropriate to your interests or role in research.
- 4. Select CITI Health Information Privacy and Security (HIPS) Basic Course.
- 5. On the Main Menu page, select Enter or Re-Enter to begin or continue the Course.
- 6. You need to complete all of the Required Modules and 2 of the Elective Module.
- 7. When you have completed the course, click on Main Menu. If you did not pass the course, you may return to any of the modules and re-take any of the Quizzes.
- 8. Print out the Completion Certificate through the link: "Print" in the Learner's menu to keep for your files. A copy will be sent automatically to COMIRB.

NEXT STEPS

Email your HIP Experience Advisor, Madison Kelleher (Madison.kelleher@ucdenver.edu) to notify you have submitted your information then she will confirm completing then get your Experience approved.

Once your Experience is approved: You will need the following to be uploaded into Denver Health's MyClinical Exchange System (access provided after Denver Health acceptance):

- Evidence of:
 - Completed Hepatitis B Series Positive Immune Titer or Declination on File.
 - Two doses of MMR Vaccine (if born on or after 1957), one dose MMR Vaccine (if born before 1957), or positive MMR Titers.
 - o Varicella Vaccination, positive immune titer, or reliable history of Varicella infection.
 - Current negative PPD (within 12 months) or negative chest x-ray (if history of positive PPD).
 - Current Tdap Vaccination.
 - Seasonal influenza vaccination (rotations occurring October March).
 - o Completed training in infection control/standard precaution (EH&S).
 - Completed HIPAA Training.
 - Background check clearance according to contractual obligations.
 - Public Health students you can provide your notification from enrollment in your program as evidence of this item.
 - All other majors you will be asked to sign a background check authorization form during your appointment.
 - School Picture ID.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1. I'm an international student, can I participate in the HIP? Yes, however, you must be CPT eligible. Please visit with your ISSS advisor to get further details.
- 2. I'm a non-degree seeking student, can I participate in the HIP? Unfortunately, you must be a degree seeking student to qualify to receive academic credit for the HIP experience. If you cannot register for academic credit or be eligible, you cannot participate in the HIP experience.
- 3. Do I have to pay tuition to participate in the HIP experience? Yes, just like any other course, you will pay tuition for 1 credit hour of academic credit.

ACADEMIC DETAILS & REQUIREMENTS

- All student HIP Experiences are required to be reported as an Experience/Learning Agreement which must be approved by the Site Supervisor and Faculty Sponsor. This ensures the integrity of the experience and addresses legal and liability issues.
- **STUDENT ELIGIBILITY**: Students must have <u>completed</u>, at minimum, <u>15 credit hours</u>. <u>Cumulative</u> <u>GPA at CU Denver must be at least 2.75</u> prior to beginning the HIP. * *If either of the requirements are not met, student may proceed with the appeals process*.
- In order to qualify for academic credit, it *must be* related to the student's area of emphasis (major).
- Students are required to take CLAS 3939 concurrently with the HIP semesters.
- For the 1-credit CLAS 3939 course, students must complete a minimum of 45 "on the job" hours.
- Fall and Spring semester require student to participate "on the job" for at least 10 weeks.
- The Experiential Learning Center at CU Denver will oversee the administrative processes and course registration for placements.
- Adhere to CU Denver code of conduct and policies as set by Site Supervisor, ELC, & Faculty Sponsor.
- All paperwork and electronic approvals must be completed prior to start date.
