

What to expect after your GI procedure

Common symptoms expected in the 48 hours post procedure:

- Sore throat
- Nausea
- Abdominal cramping/bloating
- Fatigue
- Pea sized or thin streaks of blood in your stool. You may see bright red blood in the toilet bowl or on toilet paper. This should decrease within 48 hours.
- Constipation

Contact the Denver Health GI Lab 303-602-1973 **M-F 7am-5pm** if you have any concerns or the following symptoms:

- Blood in your poop that isn't decreasing after 48 hours post procedure
- Abdominal pain that doesn't go away
- Nausea or vomiting that doesn't go away

Contact your PCP or visit a Denver Health Urgent Care if you have the following or the above symptoms:

- Back, joint, or muscle pain
- Skin rashes and other allergic reactions
- Swelling or itching
- Large clots of blood or tissue in your poop, greater in size than a pea or a thin streak of blood

Go to the nearest emergency department if you have the following:

- Life threatening medical concern
- Unable to eat or drink anything
- Fainting or trouble breathing
