HCP serves children and youth who require more health and related services than other children generally.

HCP helps families of children and youth address behavioral, developmental, educational, financial, medical and/or social needs to **optimize their health and wellness outcomes**.

There are **no restrictions or eligibility requirements** based on income or diagnosis to receive HCP services. HCP care coordination services are free.

We help families find:

- Screenings and clinics including specialty care
- Medical care, health and community services
- Financial resources, including help with insurance
- Family support groups
- Transition services
- Answers to questions



HCP assists Colorado children and youth from birth to 21 with special health care needs.
