General Guidelines:

- Once a viable intrauterine pregnancy is identified, please ask your MA to schedule the patient for the remainder of their prenatal appointments according to the low risk template, utilizing the following dot phrase: .cnmprenataltemplate
- Care may be individualized by patient choosing all on-site appointments versus alternating with telehealth appointments
- If patient chooses telehealth schedule, please dispense a BP cuff with instructions
- Provider will document under the *supervision of pregnancy* problem when the equipment has been dispensed
- Provider will document the blood pressure values taken by the patient at home during telehealth visits
- Patients with evolving health care needs may need additional on-site appointments
