Diagnosis/Definition:		
The Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD) Clinic at Eastside Clinic will follow patients with chronic progressive kidney disease that meet the following criteria:		
 Have a serum creatinine >1.5 mg/dL Are > 6 months from needing renal placement therapy Have a known diagnosis for the etiology of their renal failure. Have a PCP at Eastside Clinic. 		
Initial Diagnosis and Management:		
None required, only need to meet above criteria.		
Ongoing Management and Objectives:		
 Blood pressure control. Treatment of anemia. Timely placement of vascular access. Treatment of metabolic acidosis. Management of electrolyte abnormalities including Ca and Phos. Treatment of proteinuria. Education about renal replacement therapy. 		
Indications for Specialty Care Referral:		
Serum creatinine >1.5 mg/dL		
Test(s) to Prepare for Consult:	Test(s) Consulta	ant May Need To Do:
Chem 7, CBC	Ca, Phos, PTH, F	e studies, quantitation of proteinuria
Criteria for Return to Primary Care:		
This Clinic will co-manage the patients with their primary care provider up to the point of starting hemodialysis.
