Access scholarship application on the Pulse → Nursing Education

APPLICATION PROCESS

- An essay addressing the applicant's role in the area of Nursing and how this scholarship will impact their career must be completed. The essay must be between 300 - 500 words.
- A letter of recommendation supporting this employee's application must be submitted.
- Employee must be enrolled in an accredited education program at time of application.
- A letter from the school stating the applicant is actively enrolled, and in good academic standing.
- This is a one-time award per employee.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Available to any Denver Health employee who is employed full-time, part-time, or intermittent.
- Employee is enrolled in AD or BSN education program, MSN program, C.N.A or MA program.
- Employee must have worked at Denver Health for a minimum of 90 days & must remain employed at Denver Health for 1 full calendar year after completing the education that is paid for by the fund (this will be waived if the employee has been at Denver Health for a minimum of 4 years at the time the scholarship was awarded).
- The employee must have satisfactory performance appraisals & no corrective actions in their employee file within the last year.
- **The application must be submitted to the applicant's manager for review & signature.**
- The award will be paid directly to the institution where the employee is attending classes; the scholarship will not be paid to the employee. Please ensure that you provide the correct name & address of the institution, along with your student ID, where you are attending classes.
- The check will be issued directly to the school & is non-transferrable.
