


# GETTING READY FOR YOUR ENDOSCOPIC ULTRA SOUND (EUS)

## EUS

### **A** Plan Ahead Call **303-602-1926** if you have questions or need to schedule or change your appointment

- Your appointment is at Denver Health Medical Center, Pavillion A, 777 Bannock St., 2nd floor at Same-Day Surgery. Patient/Visitor Parking is located in the Delaware Garage (P2).
- You will need an adult to sign you out and take you home after your procedure; your procedure will need to be rescheduled if you don't have an adult to take you home. We must talk with your ride to verify their availability.
- You can expect your visit to take about 2½ to 3 hours.
- Talk to your doctor if you have questions about taking your medications or blood thinners before your EUS.
- If you use oxygen or have been told that you need to use oxygen, you **MUST** bring a full oxygen tank with you or your procedure may need to be rescheduled.



### **B** The day BEFORE your EUS

- Start drinking lots of LIQUIDS in the morning and continue all day.
  - You may have a regular diet on this day.
  - Beginning at midnight DO NOT EAT or DRINK anything until after your procedure.

### **C** The day of your EUS

- You can take your morning medications with sips of water if approved by your provider or nurse.
- It is extremely important to follow these instructions.
- Failure to follow these instructions limits the value of the EUS and **your exam may need to be rescheduled.**
