ACGME selects Denver Health for Surgical Critical Care Fellowship

Denver (Oct. 2, 2025)— Denver Health is proud to announce the newly accredited Denver Health Surgical Critical Care fellowship. Selected by the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME), Denver Health will begin taking applications for the new program for fellows to begin in August 2026.

The ACGME Surgical Critical Care fellowship is a one-year, intensive training program designed to prepare surgeons for advanced practice in managing critically ill surgical and trauma patients.

"Denver Health is an incredible training ground for the next generation of surgeons. Our trauma and surgical teams guide fellows to care for patients when life-saving care is needed most," said Mandi Roberts, MD, Surgical Intensive Care Unit Director at Denver Health.

The annual fellowship will focus on the multidisciplinary care necessary to treat critically ill surgical patients. The program includes comprehensive education, clinical training and administrative resources necessary to develop advanced proficiency in this subspeciality.

This in turn assures the public that today's residents and fellows are learning and training in a setting that is preparing them to deliver safe, high-quality medical care today and in their future practice."
